TITLE: LAWN MAINTENANCE VOLUNTEER

OBJECTIVE

- To assist with the care of the grounds of various sites in the Vancouver Island Region

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Mowing lawns with a push mower
- String trimming areas not accessible with a mower
- Light gardening on some sites
- Arrive prepared for working outdoors, with appropriate clothing and foot wear. (It is required that you wear closed toe boots at all times.)
- Record your hours before and at the end of your shift.
- Inform your supervisor if you are unable to make a designated shift.

SKILLS & EXPERIENCE

- Experience using a lawn mower and weed (string) trimmer preferred.
- Enjoy working outdoors.
- Comfortable working independently without supervision.

GIFT OF TIME

- Once per week in the Spring, twice per week in Summer, and as needed the rest of the year

TRAINING

- A general overview of *TLC's* objectives
- Orientation on the work site, areas to be mowed and trimmed, and equipment to be used.

- Provide much needed regular maintenance on properties
